1) Limiters

- a) Limiters only except of mini classes (decide later) YES (11 PL, T, B, GB, LT, UKR, CH, HK, IT, RO, HU) / NO (4 BG, S, RU, DE) / OBSTAIN (1 CZ) result is YES (11)
- b) will we use only **one limiter type during EC/WC with hat system?** YES 7 (PL, BE, BG,LT,CH,HK, CZ) / NO 7 (RU, GB, DE, IT, RO, T,S) / OBSTAIN -2 (HU,UKR) => M section leader voted YES **result is YES (8)**
- change in values not a single proposal. It can be decided later electronically

Already solved:

 unclear situations about rules - visibility of models - dark colors are not accepted, complete white boat is not accepted (can only be specified with the common sense)

<u>Incomplete proposals or no sense to vote base on previous votes:</u>

- minimum weight mini Mono/mini Hydro without battery but there is no minimum weight proposed
- China proposal was put in too late (one day before TC meeting). It could not be accepted but it has been presented and explained. Most of issues has been already solved or explained properly.
- Russian proposal is more like statement than proposal. And there is one more "like proposal" by Russians but not by team leader and not in time.
- Set a minimum weights (without battery) for mini Mono and Mini Hydro categories = incomplete proposal

Reduce the duration of the WC to 5 days = incomplete proposal (how to do it?)
