Classes: F1E, F1v3.5, F1v15, F3E, F3V: the registration (from 10.00 AM) and opening ceremony (5.00 PM) for F1-F3 will take place on July 5, with starts on July 6-8.

Mini Eco, Eco, Mini Eco Team, Eco Team, Mini FSRE, FSRE: the registration (from 10.00 AM) and opening ceremony (5.00 PM) for races will take place on July 8 with starts from July 9 to July 12.

Each for juniors and seniors.

Main Judge: Csaba Danielfy [HU] Naviga M Section leader

Protest Fee: 50 Euro

Frequencies: 2,4Ghz, 35Mhz, 40Mhz

Medal and certificates: The first three placed participants in each class will be awarded a medal and certificate.

Flags and national anthem: Each participating nation is obligated to provide 3 flags (150X100cm), and USB stick with the national anthem.
 After the closing ceremony on 6 July the flags and USB will be returned to the respective delegation leaders.

Round count: Mylaps rc4 counting via mylaps transponder.

Accommodation: Dedicated camp for competitors at the start place
 (charging electric cars at the campsite and at the starting point)

will be prohibited),

Other accommodation (hotels, pensions) available within radius of approximately 15 km.

Food: Catering and grocery shop at the start place.

Airport: Nearest airport is Poznań-Ławica (POZ) – 95km, also near is Wrocław (WRO) – 105km. Transfer service from/to airports will be possible on request.

Volunteering: If you are not interested in competing in F1-F3 Eco or FSRE classes, but want to actively participate in the World Championships, you can become a Judge Assistant, Technical Judge (checking passes on buoys, measuring tension) or Technical Support of the competition for a set number of hours per day. For Volunteers, the organizer provides commemorative clothing from the World Championships, free camping and full-day meals, as well as a World Championship Volunteer certificate.
