Constanța is one of the oldest cities in Romania, with a history spanning over 2,500 years.


It was founded in the 6th century BC under the name Tomis, as a Greek colony. Later, the city was conquered by the Romans and renamed Constantiana, in honor of Emperor Constantine the Great.

Over time, Constanța has been influenced by several civilizations: Greek, Roman, Byzantine, and Ottoman. After 1878, the city became part of Romania and developed rapidly as an important port on the Black Sea.

Constanța is one of the most visited tourist destinations in Romania, due to its location on the coast.
